The entire CIDTT syllabus in its intent, purpose and content focuses on 'active learning', which involves the learners in activities developed by the teacher—thus implying that innovation is the key to being a successful teacher. As mentioned in the CIDTT guide the teacher is independent to choose the style most comfortable to him (her). I had not thought of this ever as a teacher earlier. The freedom to think, design, and implement a given content entails much more responsibility as a teacher / facilitator. It was only after two modules I realized that I had been ignorant about aspects like 'differentiation strategies' even though I was aware of individual differences.
